1. Please do not forget our AGM to be held at Sterkfontein on Wednesday 30 November. The agenda will be send out shortly.



- 2. Our annual subs are due make sure yours are paid otherwise you may not attend the AGM and nor will your scores be counted for ranking purposes. They will only count from date of payment.
- 3. The South African Compak SA Champs will be held at Sterkfontein on 19-20 November over new ranges. If you have not entered already either with Chris Leppan or Craig Smith, please do so as soon as possible.
- 4. Recently a circular was sent to members informing them that the SA Compak Championship to be held at Sterkfontein Shooting Academy on the 19-20th of November will be the last trial for the selection of the Compak team for the African championship to be shot on the 9th to 12th of March in Bloemfontein. **This is incorrect**. The last trial will be on the 4th and 5th of February at Wattlespring Gun Club. The team will be announced after that shoot.

As far as the National Trials are concerned, it will run from the first competition after the world championship until the last competition, being the EP Compak trials, before the following World Championship. It must be at least two months prior to enable the selected team and ourselves as Compak SA the time to procure the necessary attire and make timeous application for National Colours.
